IEQG – BOM

Bear Tracks

6 ½ - inch block

Fabric: Fall Print (Gold, Red, Rust, Brown, Green, Blue)
Light Background (Tan, Beige, Taupe – print or
tone on tone)

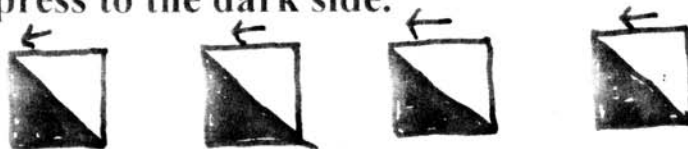
Cutting: Fall Print - 2 3-inch squares
1 4 ½-inch square

Background – 1 2 ½-inch square
2 3-inch squares

Sewing: 1. Draw a line from corner to corner on back of each 3-inch background square. Pair up the fall print and background 3-inch squares (right sides together) and sew a scant ¼-inch seam on each side of the penciled line.

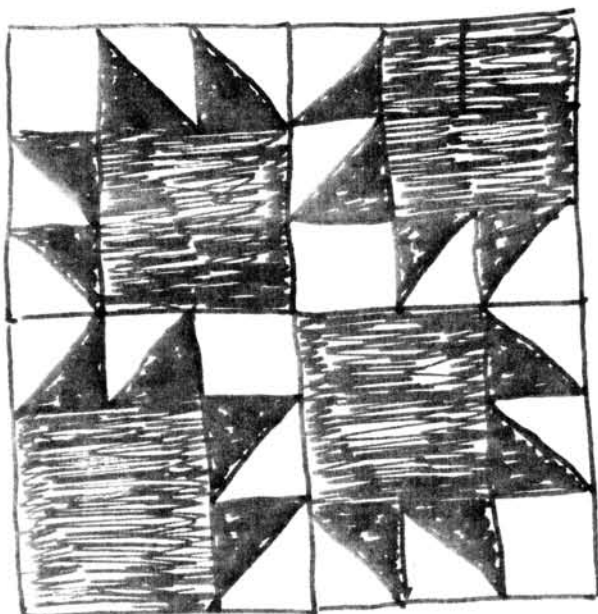
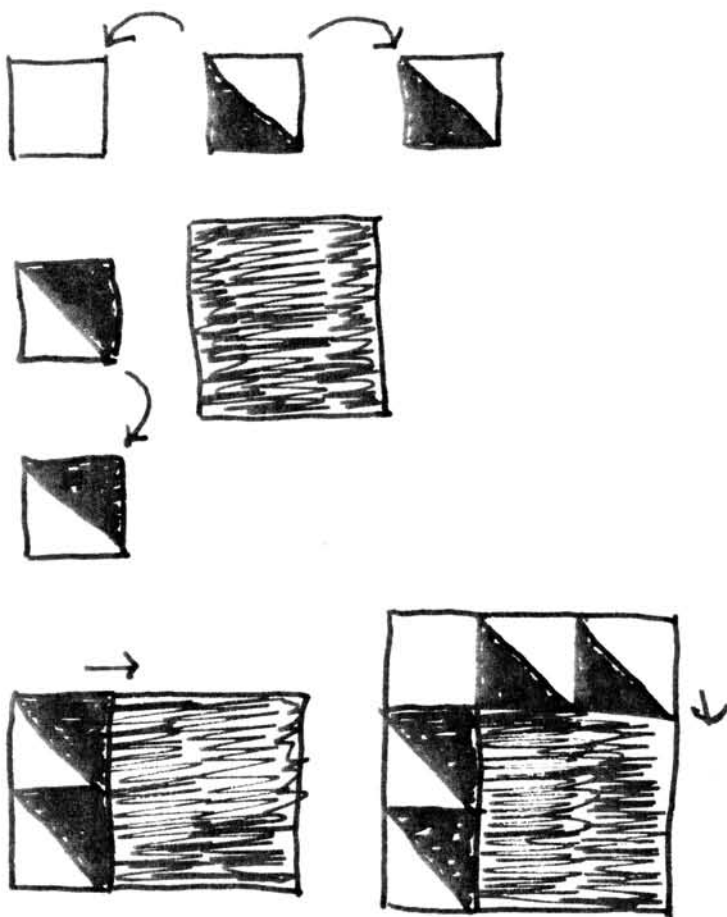


2. Press. Cut on penciled lines. Open squares and press to the dark side.



3. Trim squares to 2 ½-inch squares.

4. Layout bear track pieces and assemble.
