


IEQG – Block of the Month for August 2008

Easy Batik Pinwheels

Fabric: Two contrasting batik fabrics of your choice.

Cutting: Fabric A - Cut two 5 ½ inch squares
Cut four 3 x 5 inch rectangles

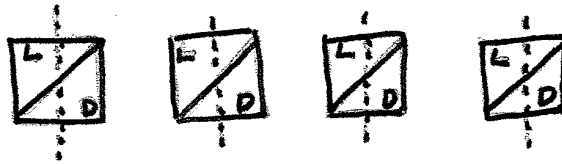
Fabric B - Cut two 5 ½ inch squares
Cut four 3 x 5 inch rectangles

Sewing: 1) Draw a line from one corner to the other on the back of the lighter 5 ½ inch squares. 

2) Pair up the two 5 ½ inch squares of fabric A with fabric B. Sew a scant ¼ inch seam on each side of the line drawn on the lighter fabric. Cut square on the penciled line. Press with the seam allowance to the darker side.

3) Trim squares to 5 inches. VERY IMPORTANT.

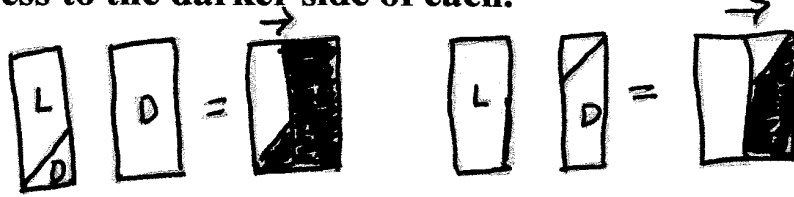
4) Line up your squares with darker side in bottom right corner. Cut each square in half.



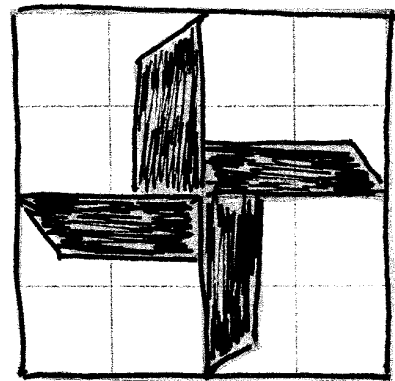
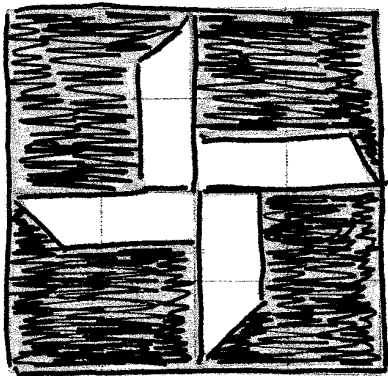
You will now have two sets of four.



- 5) Sew the 3 x 5 rectangles to the 2 ½ X 5 rectangles.
Press to the darker side of each.



- 6) Sew the units together making two pinwheel blocks.
Your blocks should measure 9 ½ inches.
