



IEQG Block of the Month – October 2009

Halloween Cat



Fabric Selection and Cutting Directions – for one block.

Color 1 – Black or Black on Black

- Two (2) 1 ½” Squares
- One (1) 3 ½” x 1 ½” rectangle
- One (1) 3 ½” x 2 ½” rectangle
- Two (2) 4 ½” x 2 ½” rectangle
- One 8” x 2 ½” strip

Color 2 – Small Halloween print with BLACK background

- One 8” x 2 ½” strip

Color 3 – Orange on Orange or Orange with small print

- One (1) 3 ½” x 1 ½” rectangle
- One (1) 3 ½” x 2 ½” rectangle
- One (1) 2 ½” x 4 ½” rectangle
- Two (2) 3” x 11 ½” strips

Assembly Instructions – All seams - ¼”

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of the Color 1 (black)– 1 ½” squares.

Step 2: Place (right sides together) the color 1 (black) 1 ½” squares on the corner’s of the color 3 (orange) 3 ½” x 1 ½” rectangle. Sew on line. Trim and press towards darker fabric.



Step 3: With right sides together, sew the two (2) color 1 & 2 - 2 ½” x 8” strips along one long edge. Press towards darkest. Cut into three (3) 2 ½” strips. Sew together as follows:

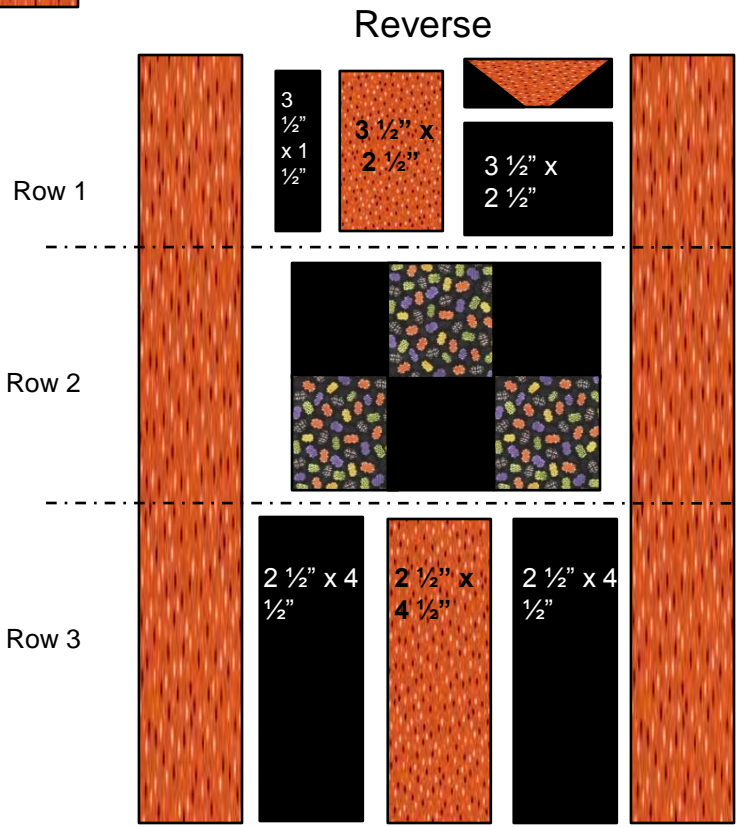
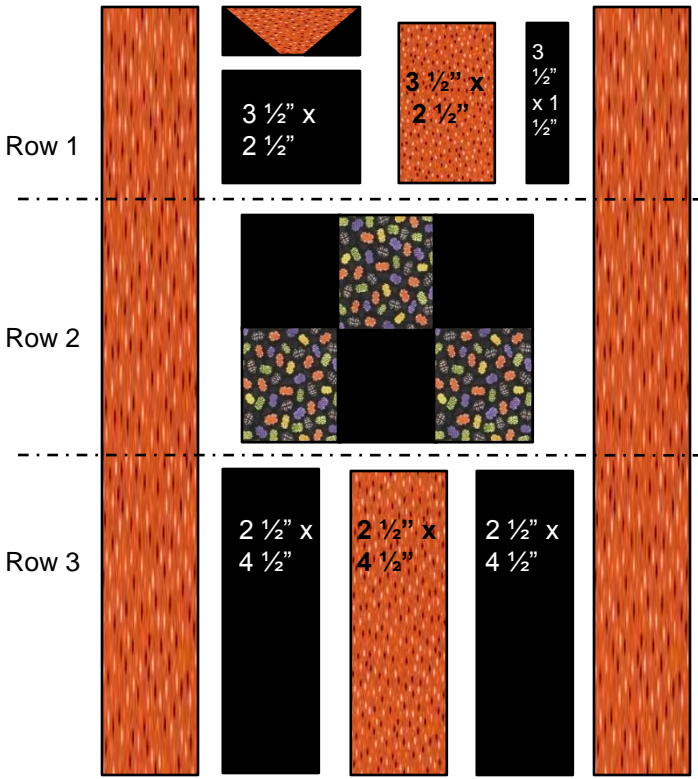


Step 4: Block assembly on next page. Make either a Right or Left sided cat or...Both. You can decorate your cat with a Halloween collar, if you wish.

Block to measure 11 ½” x 11 ½”.
