

IEQG Block of the Month – April 2010

Square Deal



Fabric Selection and Cutting Directions – for one block.

Block uses an assortment of three (3) 1930's reproduction prints and colors.

Color 1 – 1930's reproduction print

- ❑ Two (2) 2" x 10" strips
- ❑ Two (2) 2" x 13" strips

Color 2 – Contrasting 1930's reproduction print

- ❑ Two (2) 2" x 5" strips
- ❑ Two (2) 2" x 8" strips

Color 3 – Contrasting 1930's reproduction print

- ❑ One (1) 3" x 3" square

Color 4 – White or white on white

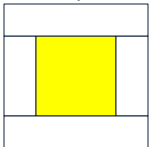
- ❑ Two (2) 1 ½" x 3" strips
- ❑ Two (2) 1 ½" x 5" strips
- ❑ Two (2) 1 ½" x 8" strips
- ❑ Two (2) 1 ½" x 10" strips

Assembly Instructions – All seams - ¼"

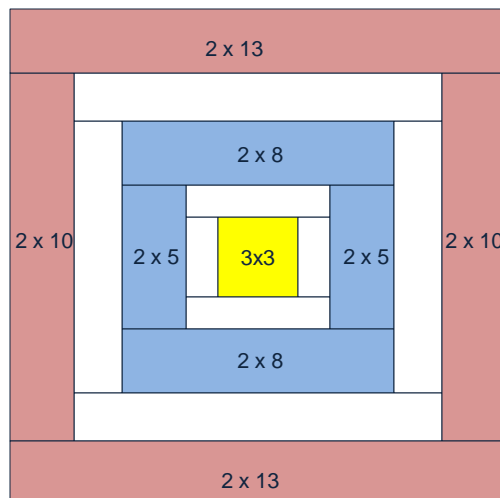
Step 1: Sew the solid white (color 4) 1 ½" x 3" rectangles to opposite edges of the 3" x 3" square (color 3). Press the seam allowances toward the solid white rectangles.



Step 2: Join the solid white (color 4) 1 ½" x 5" rectangles to the remaining edges of the 3" x 3" square (color 3) to make the block center. Press as before.



Step 3: Referring to diagram below, add the remaining assorted print and solid white rectangles to the block center as before to make a block. Always press the seam allowances away from the center.



Block to measure 12 ½" x 12 ½"
(approximate)
