

## SPOOL BLOCKS

From the brown fabric, cut:

Two (2) - 2" X 8" rectangles.

From the striped fabric, cut:

One (1) - 5" X 5" square.

From the cream fabric cut:

Two (2) - 2" X 5" rectangles

Four (4) - 2" X 2" squares

Two (2) - 1-1/2" X 8" rectangles

Two (2) - 1-1/2" X 10" rectangles

1. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong sides of the cream 2" X 2" squares.  
With right sides together, place one 2" X 2" square on top of one of the 2" X 8" rectangles one at each end. Sew across the diagonal square on the line. Press to the top. If it lines up square when you press it cut off the back 2 layers (1 brown and 1 white layer)so you don't have to many layer . Repeat to the other end of the 2" X 8" rectangle. Repeat so you have two of these. This is called a snow ball.
2. Sew the two cream 2" X 5" rectangles, one on each side of the striped 5" X 5" fabric, with the stripes going horizontal.
3. Sew spool and thread blocks together.
4. Sew the two cream 1-1/2" X 8" strips to the right and left sides.
5. Sew the two cream 1-1/2" X 10" strips to the tops and bottom of the blocks.
