

Puss in the Corner

Color 1: Grey

Cut (1) square $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$

Color 2: Black

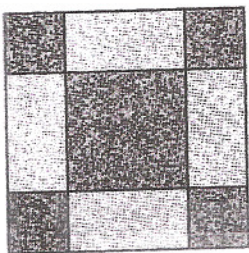
Cut (4) squares $2\frac{1}{4} \times 2\frac{1}{4}$

Color 3: Brown

Cut (4) rectangles $2\frac{1}{4} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$

Sew your black squares to your brown rectangles as pictured with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Next sew your brown rectangles to each end of your grey square. You now have three rows sewn and layed out. Sew your rows together for a completed $7\frac{1}{2}$ " block.
